If you receive a Notice of Code Violation for construction, modification or alteration of any building or structure started without a permit, it is important that you contact Building and Zoning Services at the City of Deltona.



This is what you can do:

First Step

Contact one of the Building Plans Examiners about your case. They are available to answer questions and provide additional information necessary for you to obtain a building permit, which complies with Local and State Codes.

You may have to bring additional information about your project so they can fully understand and provide direction as to what your options are. Your project may not be able to be permitted and will have to be removed.

Second Step

Once you have all the documents needed to obtain a permit, the entire package can then be submitted for approval. Your permit may be issued on the same day you apply, depending on the complexity of the project.

All members of the Building and Zoning department are trained to help you through the building process and are at your disposal.

Third Step

Call for inspection.

After a permit is issued your Code Case will be closed. But your building permit will still be opened until final building inspection.

Remember ...

The permit fee will be doubled if you start a project without a permit .

Time is important, do not delay starting the process of getting a permit.

Communicate with the Code Enforcement Officer and follow completely through the process of getting a permit and completed it.
