**Notice of Amendment - 7 Day Public Comment Period - Public**  
**Hearing**

**TO ALL RESIDENTS, AGENCIES, ORGANIZATIONS AND OTHER INTERESTED PARTIES** – In accordance with the Citizens Participation requirements of the Housing and Community Development Act, the City of Deltona wishes to inform residents of the following amendments to the FY 2008 – 2012 Consolidated Plan, affecting the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program’s 2008 Action Plan, administered by the Department of Planning and Development Services.

The American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (Recovery Act) included a one-time additional grant under the CDBG program. This grant is referred to as “CDBG-R. The proposed amendment will incorporate the CDBG-R funds and establish goals, objectives and strategies the City will use to administer and commit these funds in ways that are consistent with the recovery act, the CDBG program, special HUD guidelines for the grant and the City’s Consolidated Plan. The amount of funding allocated for the CDBG-R grant is \$135,554.

Provided below is the 2008 CDBG Action Plan’s proposed new project from the CDBG-R funding:

New Project: Storm water Drainage Pipe Rehabilitation and Upgrade \$135,554

This public hearing will be held during the regular scheduled City Commission meeting on July 6, 2009 at 6:30 p.m., at the Deltona City Hall Commission Chambers, 2345 Providence Blvd., Deltona, FL 32725. After discussion before the City Commission, the final amendments are to be approved and submitted to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development.

Accordingly, any person who may seek to appeal any decision involving the matters noticed herein will be responsible for making a verbatim record of the testimony and evidence at said meeting upon which any appeal is to be based.”
