

trash...the bin

Do your part. Help beautify Deltona.

This is a courtesy reminder from the City of Deltona & Waste Pro:

GARBAGE:

- You cannot have loose trash at the curb. Everything must be in a bin.
- You cannot mix yard waste or recyclables with your garbage.
- Your garbage bin lid was not properly closed.
- Unacceptable material was placed in your bin (hazardous waste, paint, pesticides, etc.).
- Your garbage bin was not placed at the curb correctly (wheels facing towards the house, lid opening facing the street, or more than three feet from the curb).
- One or more of your garbage bins is not compatible with Waste Pro's automated trucks.
- You have large items outside of your bin and should have called Waste Pro for a scheduled pickup (386) 574-0723.

it goes in trash...the bin

- You have placed garbage outside of the bin.
- You have more than two bins at the curb (two-bin max).
- One or more of your bins was placed at the curb at an inappropriate time with regards to your collection day.

RECYCLING:

- You have garbage or other non-recyclables mixed in with your recyclables.
- Your recycling container(s) are located more than three feet from the curb.
- Cardboard must be broken down and fit in the container.
- Recyclables cannot be placed in bags.

YARD WASTE:

- You have garbage or recyclables mixed in with your yard waste.
- Your yard waste is located more than three feet from the curb.
- Your yard waste exceeds 60 pounds per can, bag or bundle.
- Your bundled tree limbs and/or shrubs are longer than four feet in length.
- You have an excessive amount of material at the curb (more than 16 bags or bundles) and should call for a special pickup. CHARGES MAY APPLY.

- You have placed unacceptable materials at the curb (construction debris, lumber, etc.).
