3 The members were given copies of minutes from the previous board, on the discussion and
4 suggestions regarding the park signage. Mr. Moore suggested that they take it home to read and

9 **A. Trail Update:**

11 Mr. Moore told the board members that on February 25th at 10:00 a.m. there would be a ribbon
12 cutting ceremony down by the trail. They were given a copy of a map of the East Central Regional
13 Rail Trail which showed that the Deltona portion was complete. He added that the distance from
14 the Thornby property to S.R. 415 was 5.7 miles.

16 Mr. Moore did a visual presentation from the *Final Lakeshore Shared Use Path*
17 *Bicycle/Pedestrian Feasibility Study* done in December 2011 by the Volusia Transportation
18 Planning Organization, showing a map with distances.

20 **8. DIRECTOR COMMENTS:**

22 Mr. Moore said we were fortunate to have Patricia Northey as she is big on parks. He also mentioned
23 that the Philadelphia Union team had a game on Wednesday at 1:00 p.m. at Dewey Boster against
24 UCF.

26 He told the members that the Parks Department had gotten approval to install the playground at
27 Harris Saxon. He said it had 19 stations for ages 5-12 and could accommodate 54-60 kids. He
28 explained that we were given a \$30,000 grant from Community Development Block Group (CDBG).

30 He also told them that he would be out on sick leave for the next 2 meetings and that Mark Manning
31 would be filling in for him.

33 **9. MEMBERS COMMENTS:**

35 a. Ms. Srebernak said she knows there are budget constraints but she had seen positive
36 comments on Facebook that complimented the City's parks which also expressed the hope
37 that they would not take any away. She suggested that wherever there are benches, we
38 should put garbage cans.

40 b. Mr. Chinchay talked about his schedule and the time change to the meetings.

42 c. Mr. DeLeon said he was excited about the trail and said Deltona residents should be happy
43 with it.

45 d. Mrs. Deyette apologized for being late.
