4 for the Christmas Parade on December 15th. He also mentioned Santa's North Pole at the Deltona
5 Library on Saturday, December 8th from 4:00-8:00pm as well as the Hispanic Christmas Concert
6 at the Amphitheater on Friday, December 14th.

16 **7. NEW BUSINESS:**

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18 **A. Discussion on Disabled Parking Permit Rules:**

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20 Mrs. Langston wanted to know if the new members of the City Commission were up to speed on the
21 ADA Plan. Mr. Moore reminded the committee that the plan had been approved and said it was more
22 a housekeeping effort.

24 Mr. Primack said he is very frustrated with the problems as the handicap parking does not meet
25 criteria. He said he attended a Citizens Academy program with Volusia County and had met with
26 code enforcement there who said they appreciated the situation but it was not their department. He
27 said this was brought to the attention of Sheriff Ben Johnson as well. Mr. Primack said there are a lot
28 of places that do not meet the criteria including post offices, shopping malls, schools and businesses.
29 He said he could understand why Captain Brannon did not want to enforce the fines, especially if the
30 dollar amount is not displayed on the sign, but he feels that people know if they park in certain places
31 i.e. by a fire hydrant, in a no parking or fire lane or in a handicap space then they know there is going
32 to be a consequence.

34 Mr. Moore said that once the new City Commission gets settled, we can look at the January meeting
35 to talk about it. Mr. Moore said he could draft something and maybe they could attend a Commission
36 Meeting to address it. He said we could see if Deltona can start the process since they face these
37 daily challenges. He reminded the committee that Deltona is the only city in Volusia County with an
38 ADA Plan.

40 Mr. Primack said that he knows when new developers come in they obviously have to meet the new
41 parking requirements. Mr. Moore advised that the Building Official is the City's ADA Coordinator.

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43 **B. Other:**

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45 Mrs. Brown asked for volunteers to help decorate the Santa's North Pole the week of December 3rd.

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47 Mrs. Langston mentioned that she had visited Dewey Boster and noticed that a bench needed to be

1 repaired. Mr. Moore advised that it would be taken care of and stated that if any member sees a
2 problem at the park they can call the office so repairs can be handled in a timely manner. Mr. Weston
3 from Home Depot stated that they had purchased a bench through the City and he knows it is used
4 and appreciated.

6 It was agreed that in January 2013 the committee would start discussions on the ADA Transition Plan
7 and the Community Expo scheduled for June 2013.

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9 **8. DIRECTOR COMMENTS:**

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11 Mr. Moore told the members that the board has now lost two (2) members so going forward this
12 committee needs to have 5 people in attendance in order to hold a meeting. He asked them to call
13 ahead if they cannot attend a meeting so that staff can contact members in advance of them
14 heading out to the meeting, if the meeting needs to be cancelled for lack of a quorum.
