**7. NEW BUSINESS:**

**A. Discussion on Disabled Parking Permit Rules:**

Mr. Moore wanted to leave this item until there was a full board; however, there was some discussion. Mr. Moore stated that he has been reviewing the parking permit and wondered what could be done as a group to help with this process.

Mrs. Dockery suggested coming up with an educational pamphlet that they could place on vehicles if they see someone doing what they should not. Mr. Moore explained that the City does not allow people in our parks to solicit, so what would the difference be, if they put these pamphlets on vehicles. Mr. Dockery suggested sending a form letter to businesses in the area.

Mr. Moore said we could develop a pamphlet that would run on our television station. He added that we could have copies made to give to people who come to City Hall for business licenses, to see if they are compliant with the handicap code. Mr. DeLeon wanted to know if they could get a spot on the television station to talk about this issue. Mrs. Beauregard suggested this board get a table at the Community Expo to help bring awareness to the public; she said there are things she did not even know. The suggestion was made to come up with a list of questions prior to the June meeting so they could prepare for the Community Expo. Mr. Primack said it would be nice to come up with something lighthearted with some dialogue, but to make it educational. Mr. DeLeon said images have more impact. Mrs. Beauregard agreed that it could be lighthearted but it should send the message.

**Motion by Patsy Dockery, seconded by Thomas Dockery to make an educational pamphlet and to move forward with this project. Motion carried with members voting as follows: Julio DeLeon, For; Micky Beauregard, For; Thomas Dockery, For; Patsy Dockery, For; Sandy Primack, For; and Joy Primack, For.**

Mr. Primack asked Mr. Moore if he was amenable to taking pictures of businesses to show some of the problems and non-problems. Mr. Moore said it appears that we have a challenge.

**B. Updates:**

Mr. Moore informed the board about the ACCESS West Volusia group that provides resources for our residents at the Wes Crile Park every other month, alternating with Deland. He advised that the service would not be available during the months of June and July due to summer camp at that location.

Mr. Moore advised that 10 new handicap signs will be made for City Hall. He said all the parking signs will be updated with the fines and relevant information.

1 He gave them an update on Audubon Park off Doyle Road which backs up to the East Central Rail  
2 Trail. He stated that this past week some work was done to allow access by bike. He told them there  
3 would be a ribbon cutting ceremony on April 19<sup>th</sup> at 3:00 p.m. and added that we were partnering  
4 with the Audubon Society. He talked about the trail and the vegetation and said it is like a “hidden  
5 beauty”. He added that there are handicap spaces that meet the requirements.

7 Mr. Moore did a visual presentation and explained that we are trying to do a system of trails and  
8 indicated that we are looking at putting a trail on the easements in phases to include some  
9 undeveloped locations like Cooper Park, Brewster and Coachman to use as trail heads as well as  
10 Keyville. He also talked about a trail coming out of Thornby, with a sidewalk to the park that will  
11 continue to the entrance, go across the street and run all the way to Green Springs Park, saying that  
12 we would be connecting a City park with the Deltona Community Center and a County trail. He  
13 explained that it is already designed and said that connecting several parks could bring economic  
14 development to the City. He said this was a partnership with TPO at an estimated \$583,000 with  
15 construction to be completed in 2015.

19 Mr. Moore had no further comments.

21 **9. MEMBER COMMENTS:**

23 a. Mrs. Dockery said she is excited about the Expo and the educational pamphlet which  
24 should include parking spaces, etc. She said it is essential for people to be able to  
25 function in the community especially in this economic situation.

27 b. Mr. Dockery stated that the needs that they are addressing here are very important, not  
28 just to them, but to the City as well. He said we need to make it a better place for  
29 everyone to live.

31 c. Mr. Primack said he and Mrs. Primack are both excited about this. He said it is a good  
32 idea to do the pamphlet, a video, to survey the City, etc.

34 d. Mrs. Beauregard agreed that education will take us far.  
35  
36 e. Mr. DeLeon said that education will bring awareness and added that since he has  
37 joined this board he is more aware of handicap issues. He agreed that images (a video)  
38 will have more of an impact.
