Regular Meeting

1. CALL TO ORDER:

The meeting was called to order at 5:30 p.m. by the Chair, Bernice Ludvick.

3. APPROVAL OF MINUTES & AGENDA:

A. Regular Minutes - August 25, 2015

Motion by Vice Chair Malave, second by Member Nadeau, to approve the Regular Minutes of August 25, 2015. The motion carried by the following vote:

4. PRESENTATIONS/AWARDS/REPORTS:

Staff provided members the following flyers: Game Changers Basketball Academy Fall Schedule; Stormwater Pollution Prevention Public Forum; Latin Arts & Music Festival; Florida Hospital Pink Feet 5/10K Road Race and the City of Deltona's Community Visioning Workshops.

5. PUBLIC FORUM:

No member of the public was present.

6. OLD BUSINESS:

A. Planning of the Arts & Crafts Festival

The Senior Advisory Sub-Committee and staff discussed the approved vendors and their crafts/artwork. Staff informed members that a total of twenty (20) vendors had already registered which includes two (2) food vendors.

The food vendors will be set up on the court yard near the same location as last year without access to the stage. Mr. Moore informed the Sub-Committee that the stage will be blocked off and not accessible to the public.

There was further discussion on the need for signs leading buyers to the indoor vendors. Staff explained that name badges will be required for volunteers, vendors and their guest to wear which will allow them to enter the Commission Chambers kitchen area.

Member Speir suggested that the event run for a longer duration of time if it continues to grow each year. All members agreed with Mr. Speir.

B. Development of a Senior Services Resource Publication

Staff provided members a draft copy of the Senior Services Resource Publication. Members and staff discussed what was already listed and other services they felt should be added.

Local service providers such as Red Cab, Deltona Memorial, Council On Aging and Career Source were discussed. Members decided to list multiple companies based in surrounding cities who offer a service that our Deltona senior population would benefit from and is currently not established in Deltona.

Staff urged members to continue sending information on additional services that they feel would belong on the publication. Members are hoping to have a final product for distribution during the Arts & Crafts Festival in November.

7. NEW BUSINESS:

A. Department Updates - Steve Moore

Mr. Moore spoke to members about the Festival of Nations that had taken place on September 19, 2015. He told them about the \$3,700 received in donations from organizations all over the state and that the event had come in \$5,000 under budget. Mr. Moore said that the timing of the festival will need to be reviewed explaining that the attendance was extremely low at the very beginning but did pick up later in the day.

Mr. Moore informed the Senior Advisory Sub-Committee that a lighted football field is budgeted to be built at Dwight Hawkins and an additional lighted baseball field would be built at Manny Rodriguez. Stating that these fields will benefit multiple local leagues that do not have a place to practice or play their games because of the current lack of

outdoor lighting available in Deltona Parks.

Mr. Moore mentioned that as of September 21 the FY15/16 budget was approved. He also mentioned the approval of a Senior Center to be built near Station 65 on the 17.5 acres to include a full size gym, meeting rooms, a full kitchen or two (2) and a banquet hall geared to host large events such as high school gradations. He explained that across Howland Blvd. there are plans to build a large sports complex or stadium. There will be a committee established and a time line of two or more years for completion.

Member Speir stated that he believes the Department of Elder Affairs offer funding towards building of senior centers. He will bring the information to the next meeting.
