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7 **a. Teen Game Day:**

14 advised that the electronic message boards would be placed at strategic points to advertise the
15 event and stated that if there was a big turnout we could extend it for an hour beyond the 2:00 p.m.

24 get back with the PIO person for a revision to the flyer. The new flyer would be distributed at the

28 host the event at Harris Saxon as the flooring there was better for handling food, etc. instead of the
29 gym floor at Wes Crile Park. This was going to be a free event open to teens.

31 It was agreed by the sub-committee that the age group would be 14 to 18. The discussion
32 then turned to the dress code. It was decided that the dress code needed to be stated on the flyer.
33 There was quite a discussion on this subject and it was finally decided that it should follow the school
34 dress code. Instead of a dress theme it was decided that it should be a "fall dance". Sarah Figueroa
35 said she had a copy of the school dress code which she could provide to Mrs. Brown. Mr. Moore said
36 it should be similar to "Volusia County School Dress Code". Mr. Moore said once the flyer was
37 completed he would forward it to Diane Smith as he had already spoken with her.

39 The members were told that they could dress up for this event since they would only be
40 doing a minimal amount of work. The members asked about snacks and Mr. Moore said yes, we
41 would provide some snacks including popcorn.
